7 PRINCIPLES OF XERISCAPING



Planning & Design

Consider your natural property features like soil type, sun exposure, rainfall, & wind patterns.



Soil Improvement

Add organic matter like compost to improve soil structure & fertility. Good soil helps retain moisture and supports plant health.



PlantSelection

Select drought-tolerant plants that require minimal water and are ideally suited to your climate. Native plants are frequently recommended being well-adjusted to local ecosystems.



Mulch

Add a top layer of mulch to help retain soil moisture & suppress weeds. Decomposing mulch will also add nutrients to the soil.



Efficient Irrigation

Use drip irrigation, soaker hoses, & watering cans to minimize water waste. Water plants at the base to reduce evaporation and runoff. Aim to water plants before 10 AM or after 5PM to reduce evaporative loss.



Landscape Design

Incorporate hardscaping elements like pathways, patios, & walls to reduce lawn areas and minimize water use. Use rocks, gravel, & other non-plant materials for creative permeable design.



Maintenance

Monitor plant health, adjusting irrigation, and managing weeds. Maintenance ensures long-term success & optimized water efficiency.

The Hawaiian word 'pono' carries a lot of depth and meaning. The Hawaiian dictionary lists over 80 English translations, with the most common one being "righteousness."

Planting pono means choosing to grow things that are appropriate and beneficial for the landscape.
