

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

(Chapter 103D, HRS)

SEALED BIDS for **SERVICE BID NO. 2025-04, WAIMEA WATER TREATMENT PLANT (WWTP) SLUDGE REMOVAL**, District of South Kohala, County of Hawai'i, State of Hawai'i, will be received ELECTRONICALLY by the Department of Water Supply, County of Hawai'i, until **May 1, 2025, at 2:30 p.m.** Bids received after the time fixed for opening or delivered elsewhere other than specified herein will not be considered.

The project generally consists of paying for all labor, materials, tools, taxes, and equipment necessary to remove and dispose of settled sludge, from the Waimea Water Treatment Plant 2.7MG and 8.5MG reservoirs, and drying beds as needed, for a contract period starting from the date of the Notice to Proceed and ending June 30, 2026. Removal of the sludge is on an as-needed basis and the total cost throughout the duration of the contract shall not exceed \$350,000.00.

A pre-bid meeting and site visit shall be scheduled for April 16, 2025 at 9:00a.m. at the Department of Water Supply's Waimea Water Treatment Plant. Bidders shall notify the project engineer, Dillon Kodama, (808) 961-8790, by 3:30p.m. on April 15, 2025 to indicate their attendance and for directions. Should no notifications be received, the pre-bid meeting and site visit shall be cancelled. All potential interested bidders, offerors, subcontractors, and union representatives are invited to attend.


To be eligible to submit a bid, the Bidder, or subcontractor, must possess current registration with the State Department of Health, Wastewater Branch, as a pumper.
